Criteria for the CIIPA Outstanding Member Award

General Criteria:

- Minimum 10 years post qualification
- CIIPA member in good standing
- Other accounting body in good standing

Key Considerations:

- Significant career achievements
- Demonstrates commitment in community or volunteer services
- Contributes to the development of young professional accountants
- Significant commitment and contribution to the accounting profession

General Rules:

- Each nominator may submit only one nominee for consideration.
- An individual may only win the award once.
- The award is given at the discretion of the selection committee.
- Individuals may be re-nominated in future years, or the selection committee may contact past nominees for future considerations, providing individuals still meet the award criteria.
