



Designated Non-Financial Business and Profession (DNFBP) Registration Form

This registration form should be completed by firms of accountants that carry on, or intend to carry on, business as a DNFBP pursuant to the Anti-Money Laundering Regulations (2025 Revision) (the "AMLRs").

Introduction

Pursuant to the AMLRs, CIIPA is the designated Supervisory Authority for firms of accountants. A firm of accountants that carries on, or intends to carry on, business as a DNFBP in or from within the Cayman Islands is required to register with CIIPA in accordance with the AMLRs.

As part of the registration process, CIIPA may require an applicant to provide documents, statements or other information necessary to determine whether the applicant is carrying on relevant financial business as defined by Schedule 6 of the Proceeds of Crime Act (2025 Revision) and to assess whether the applicant and its beneficial owners and connected persons satisfy applicable fit and proper requirements.

The applicant may not carry on business as a DNFBP unless and until CIIPA has confirmed in writing that the registration has been approved or otherwise determined that registration requirements have been satisfied.

How to Complete this Registration Form:

Where necessary, guidance is provided before the relevant question. Please read the guidance carefully before completing the form.

Complete the form electronically wherever possible and provide all supporting documents requested.

If additional space is required to answer a question, please attach a separate sheet and clearly identify the section to which the information relates.

Points to note

To enable CIIPA to assess the application, applicants may be required to provide supporting documentation including:

- constitutional and formation documents;
- ownership and control information;
- details of beneficial owners and connected persons;
- fit and proper questionnaires and supporting documents;
- AML/CFT policies and procedures;
- information relating to AML officers; and
- any additional information reasonably requested by CIIPA.

CIIPA may request further information at any stage of the registration process where necessary to assess compliance with the AMLRs or determine the applicant's AML/CFT risk profile.

Important Notice

Registration as a DNFBP under the AMLRs is separate from registration as a Public Practice Firm or Sole Practitioner under the Accountants Act (2024 Revision).

Where the applicant engages in public practice, registration under both frameworks may be required.

6.3 Money Laundering Reporting Officer ("MLRO")

The Anti-Money Laundering Regulations require that every person carrying out relevant financial business designate a person employed at managerial level as the Money Laundering Reporting Officer. The MLRO is responsible for securing compliance with Part 4 of the Proceeds of Crime Act (as revised) and for receiving and considering internal disclosures of suspected money laundering, terrorist financing or proliferation financing. The MLRO is a connected person of the DNFBP and must complete the Fitness and Propriety Questionnaire.

The Anti-Money Laundering Regulations require that every person carrying out relevant financial business designate a manager or official at managerial level as the Deputy Money Laundering Reporting Officer.
