Financial Controllers Update

Description/Overview

This IFRS and US GAAP Technical Update course has been specifically developed to bring experienced preparers and users of financial statements up-to-date with recent developments. Course content includes coverage of newly effective and newly issued IFRSs and Interpretations, recent amendments to existing Standards and Interpretations, Exposure Drafts and other recent developments. The course will also look at relevant global issues and discuss accounting for strategic transactions in some detail.

To provide technical updates both industry and audit professionals.

Financial controllers, finance directors, auditors of commercial companies and accounting staff.

Tax Update

Description/Overview

Keep up-to-date with the latest developments in the tax and tax-related regulatory environment. Topics will include tax issues important to investment industry stakeholders in both the Cayman Islands and US.

To provide regulatory/tax updates for both industry and audit professionals.

Insurance Update

Description/Overview

This course will provide an update on the latest developments impacting the insurance industry, including audit, tax and regulatory updates. The panel of speakers will discuss the continued impact of COVID-19 and other macro-economic factors on the Insurance Industry.

Learning Objectives

To provide an insurance industry update for both audit professionals and accountants in the insurance industry.

Who should attend?

Insurance industry professionals, accounting staff and directors of insurance companies.

Insolvency Update

Description/Overview

This course will provide a brief refresh on the basics of insolvency procedures in the Cayman Islands while exploring some of the more advanced and complicated aspects of a liquidation process and the challenges faced working in an offshore jurisdiction. Topics will include an update on current events and regulations impacting the insolvency industry in the Cayman Islands.

Learning Objectives

An introduction for accountants to the insolvency industry and an update on current events and regulations impacting the industry.

Where Online / In person

Who should attend?

This course is designed for individuals with a basic understanding of or currently working in the insolvency industry.

CPD Credits: 2.5 hours



Hedge Funds IFRS & US **GAAP Update**

Description/Overview

This course will provide an annual update on new accounting pronouncements under IFRS and US GAAP that will be applicable to hedge funds for the upcoming financial year end. The course is split into two sections, accounting standards updates pertaining to hedge funds and preparation of US/IFRS compliant financial statements.

Learning Objectives

An introduction for accountants to the hedge fund industry and an update on current events and regulations impacting the industry.

When Q4 of the calendar year.

Where In person

Who should attend?

This course is designed for financial statement preparers and auditors.

CPD Credits: 8 hours

Business Environment Update

Description/Overview

The Business Environment Update is a 3-day event for professionals across all industries in Cayman. Focus areas include:

- Cayman Islands economic update from the Minister of Finance
- Cayman Islands regulatory updates
- Updates on current events shaping Cayman's business environment and impacting your business
- Outlook for the upcoming year

Learning Objectives

Presenters will provide an update on recent changes impacting the business and regulatory environment in Cayman, and provide opportunities for professionals to expand their knowledge on topical issues impacting businesses and finance professionals in Cayman.

Where Online / In person

Who should attend? This course is designed for all accounting professionals in Cayman.

CPD Credits: 6 hours



Auditing Standards Update

Description/Overview

Covers key ISA requirements and updates, focusing on the revised ISAs and application for Cayman funds.

Learning Objectives

To improve attendees' understanding of the current ISA requirements and ISAs in the pipeline, with a focus on Cayman funds.

When Q3 of the calendar year.

Where Online / In person

Who should attend? This course is applicable to auditors across industry as a number of the topics are generic, however there is a focus on Cayman funds. The course is also applicable to those collaborating with auditors of Cayman funds, including administrators, directors and regulators.

CPD Credits: 3 hours

AML/PF/TF Update

Description/Overview

Updates on hot topics in Compliance including Anti-Money Laundering, Proliferation Financing and Terrorist Financing and the related Cayman Islands Laws and Regulations.

Learning Objectives

This training session aims to raise awareness and general knowledge into Anti-Money Laundering and Anti-Proliferation Financing and Terrorist Financing, particularly as it relates to accountants. Furthermore, the session will provide status updates on changes in regulation and the status of the Cayman Islands as it pertains to the FATF.

When Q1 of the calendar year.

Where Online / In person

Who should attend? Corporate service providers, fund administrators, accounting firm compliance professionals and, in general, accountants involved in onboarding of clients.

CPD Credits: 3 hours



Ethics

Description/Overview

An interactive session that will address ethical dilemmas faced by accounting professionals and assist individuals in considering how they identify and respond to certain ethical dilemmas.

Learning Objectives

This training session aims to provide accounting professionals with the opportunity to reflect on and improve how they identify and respond to ethical dilemmas and scenarios, and, where possible, provide solutions on how to resolve an ethical issue and guidance on when it might be necessary to escalate to a supervisor or board.

Who should attend? This course is applicable to all finance professionals.

CPD Credits: 2 hours

IPSAS and **IFRS** Update for **Public Sector**

Description/Overview

Technical accounting standards update designed for the entire public sector covering both IPSAS and IFRS updates. This will be an immersive event using CIG financial statements to work through the implications of changes to the accounting standards on local organisations and the steps that individuals should take to prepare effectively for year end.

Learning Objectives

To provide an update for public and government accountants on recent changes and proposed changes to the IPSAS and IFRS standards.

Where Online / In person

Who should attend? Accountants working in government and the public sector and those working on Public Sector Audit Engagements.
