Are you on top of your CPD? All Regular Members of CIIPA are required to comply with the CPD requirements of their overseas professional accounting institute or “OPAI”. If your OPAI’s requirements do not adhere to International Education Standards, the requirement is *120 hours in each rolling three-year period to 31 December with a minimum of 20 hours in each and 60 verifiable hours during that period*. As a full member of IFAC, CIIPA is responsible for monitoring its members CPD which is done on an annual basis.
